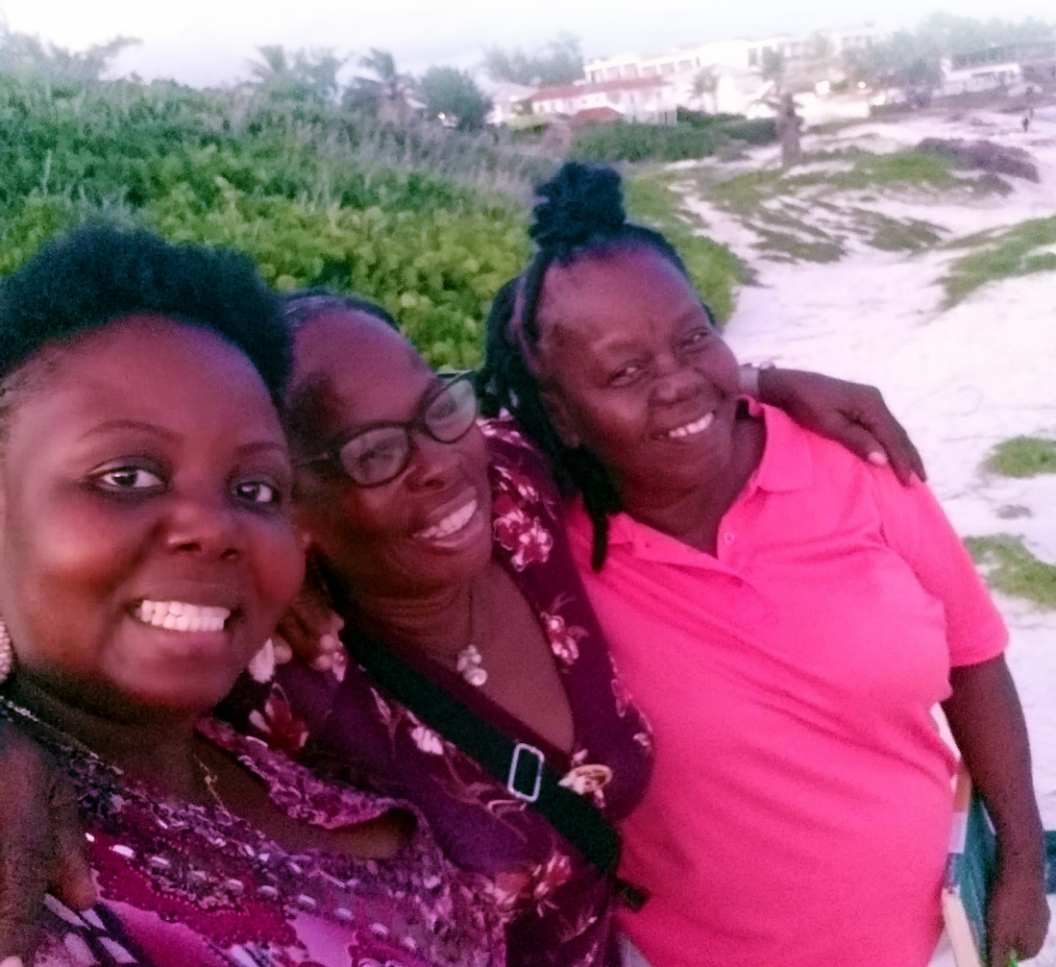

With the daystar shining o'er us.

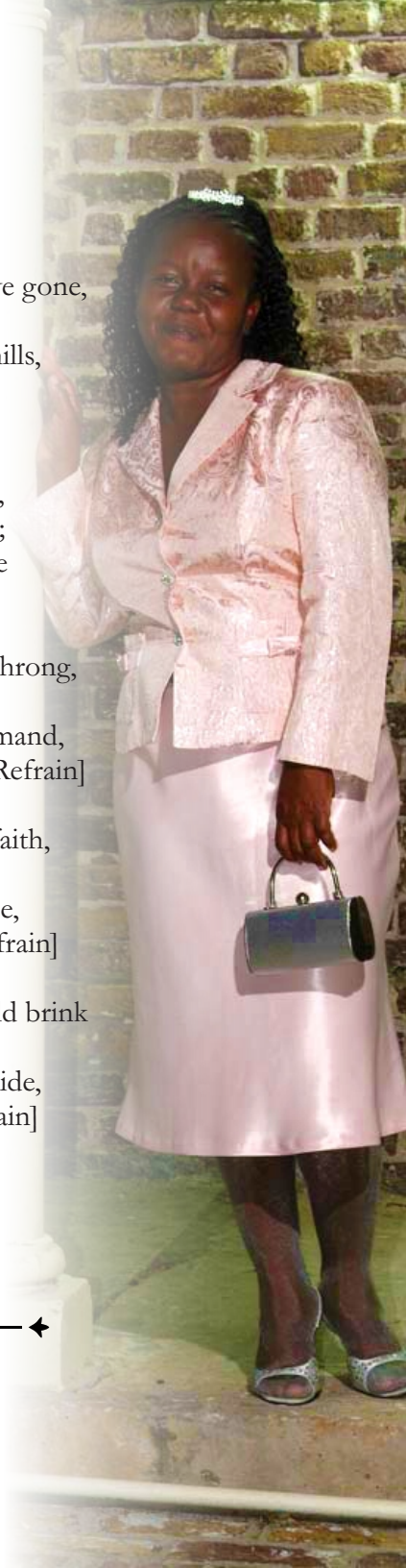
