my heart and tongue employ.

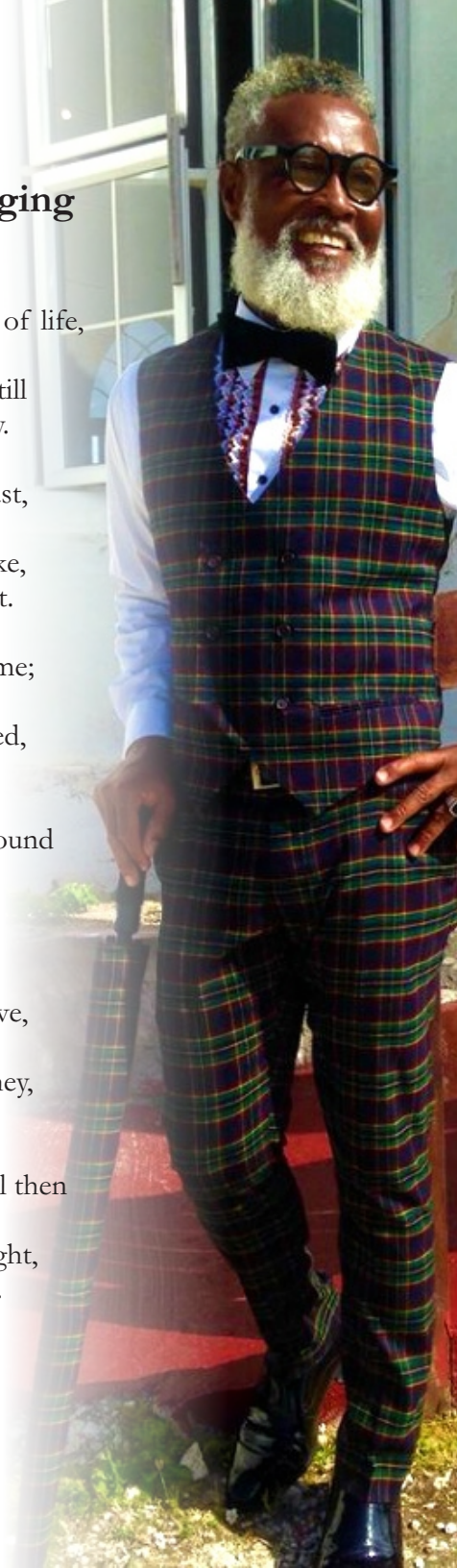
2 Of his deliv'rance I will boast,

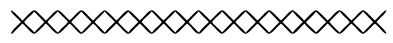








At the Graveside
